WHO WE SERVE

We provide FREE primary medical care, basic dental care, behavioral health services, vision, dermatology, and health and wellness education to those aged 19-64 who are uninsured or underinsured.

I am pleased to present the annual Impact Report of the Jean B. Purvis Community Health Center for 2024. This past year has been one of growth, challenges, and achievements. I am proud to share our progress with you.

The Center has seen an increase in patient visits by 32.5% and 18.18% in our Behavior Health referrals. Our dental care has increased by 21.93% this past year.

The Center's success is due to the volunteers and dedicated staff that make up the CHC team. Last year, Taylor Thomas joined our team as Dental Director, and Amy Arnold, from Huntington Bank, accepted a position on the Board of Directors. We are pleased to welcome both professionals as we look ahead with excitement for new opportunities in the coming year.

As the year closed, our Dental Director, J Gary McHugh retired. He has been a long-standing member of the CHC team since 2012. His dedication to our dental patients and his expertise in recruiting new dentists will be sorely missed.

I want to extend my heartfelt thanks to our dedicated staff, volunteers, and practitioners. I want to give a special thanks to our donors for their unwavering commitment to our mission. Together we are making a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of our community.

Taylor Thomas joined the Community Health Center as our Dental Manager in April of 2024. Taylor has formal dental assisting training obtained in 2014 from Ross Medical Education Center of Niles, Ohio, as well as over 10 years of experience in the clinical and administrative aspects of the dental field. Originally from the Youngstown, Ohio area, Taylor now lives in Emlenton with her husband James, and their four children.

SERVICES

MEDICAL

Outpatient primary medical care, preventative medical services, treatment of acute and chronic illnesses, referrals for specialized services, referrals to other agencies when appropriate, select immunizations, and free medications when possible.

CHC Drug Room distributed over \$103,101.78 in medications in 2024.

DENTAL

Quality basic dentistry including preventative, restorative dental care, and oral education at no cost. The CHC cares for patients who have no dental insurance or have limited dental coverage. Services are provided to individuals aged 19 to 64 and veterans of any age.

In 2024, 7 dentists gave their time and served 650 patients.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

The Center provides treatment related to anxiety and depression. Physicians work with patients to develop a treatment plan and medication is prescribed and monitored as warranted and needed. The Center has continued its partnership with a Licensed Professional Counselor to provide short-term counseling.

Behavioral Health services were provided to 126 patients in 2024.

VISION

Comprehensive eye exams and glasses (as prescribed) are provided. Regular eye exams help to reduce the chance of blindness and vision loss while staying on top of developing eye diseases such as cataracts and glaucoma.

In 2024, \$10,723 worth of glasses were provided to our patients.

DERMATOLOGY

Provided by UPMC Mobile Dermatology to improve access to dermatology, to protect the largest organ in the human body. Dr. Alaina James, a Pitt University medical student, and UPMC continue their partnership with the Community Health Center.

Dermatology services were provided to 17 CHC patients in 2024.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

The Center's Health & Wellness team provides classes and education such as diabetes education, weight loss management, understanding your medication, healthy eating, smoking cessation, managing stress, and MORE!

The CHC Health & Wellness team provided education to 1098 patients in 2024.

THE MANY FACES WE SEE

➤ I am a 42-year-old female who is married with no insurance. I am a college graduate who is currently unemployed but is in the process of starting a new job. My household includes myself and my husband, and we have a combined income that is under 100% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. I needed help with obtaining my TB test for employment, but couldn't afford it out-of-pocket. I was able to be seen at the Community Health Center to get my TB test done and start my new job!

➤ I am a 59-year-old male who is divorced with no insurance. I am currently working full-time in the vocational field making less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. My household includes just myself. I needed help with my teeth, as I was experiencing painful gums and cavities that needed to be treated. All of my dental needs were taken care of at the Community Health Center, and now I am pain-free!

➤ I am a 63-year-old widowed female with no insurance. I am a high school graduate who is working part-time and currently makes less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. I needed help with my vision as well as prescription refills as I had not seen a doctor in many years and was experiencing dizziness and vision changes. I was able to get my medication refilled and was provided with a pair of free glasses from the Community Health Center!

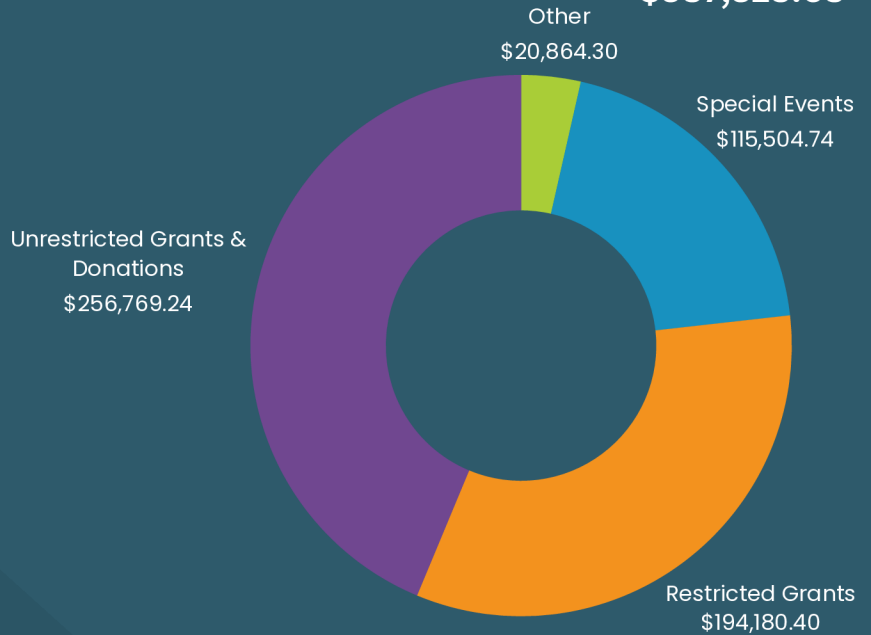

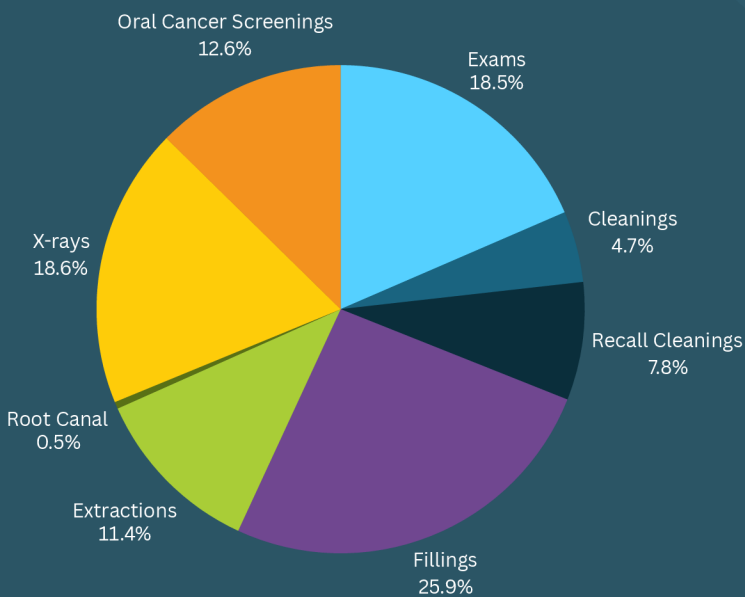
