In 2008, I was a single mom of a 3-year-old son with no significant education, employment, or family support. The VOICe counselor insisted that I needed welfare and that it was a handup, not a handout. My primary goal was to attend Butler County Community College (BC3) to become a registered nurse.

I was accepted into the BC3 Nursing Program through hard work and dedication to my courses. The program required an annual physical exam and vaccinations. I presented to the Butler Community Health Center. The clinicians were courteous, kind, respectful, and nonjudgmental. The staff created an inviting environment for care. During two years of nursing school, I received examinations and vaccines at no cost. The only request that was made of me was to become a good RN.

With the help and assistance of the Community Health Center, I was able to graduate from BC3 Nursing School Program in 2011.

I have gravitated to those needing my skills the most and pay it forward every chance. I currently have the Community Engagement & Partnership Coordinator position at the VA in Butler, providing suicide prevention training, education, and resources for five counties. I was awarded a scholarship through the VA in 2018 for my masters. I finished my MSN in Administration with Leadership from the University of Phoenix with a 3.7 GPA.

I provide a hand-up daily and never forget those who have helped me. I go to work with a smile and goodness in my heart, and I am very thankful I am employed in a career that allows me to give back.

Now you might be wondering why I am writing this letter. The Community Health Center does not consistently get recognized for its excellent work.

Please know I am one of your success stories!

I would have never become an RN otherwise. I tell everyone who needs to hear it that a hand-up pulls you in a positive direction for those strong enough to grab on.

The Community Health Center had a hand in making a nurse who makes a difference on the front line daily.

Your kind, supportive approach will always be remembered.



Outpatient primary medical care, preventive medical services, treatment of acute and chronic illnesses, referrals for specialized services, referrals to other agencies when appropriate, select immunizations and free medications when possible.

CHC Drug Room distributed over \$107,000 in medications in 2022





Quality basic dentistry including preventative, restorative dental care, and oral education at no cost. The CHC cares for patients who have no dental insurance or have limited dental coverage. Services are provided to individuals age 19 to 64 and to Veterans of any age. In 2022, six Dentists gave their time and saw over 700 patients in 2022



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

The Center provides treatment related to anxiety and depression. Physicians work with patients to develop a treatment plan and medication is prescribed and monitored as warranted and needed. New in 2022, the Center has partnered with a Licensed Professional Counselor to provide short-term counseling. Counseling can help the patient to better understand themselves and others, to set goals and to work toward change.

Behavioral Health saw an increase in patient need of 33% in 2022



VISION

Comprehensive eye exams and glasses (as prescribed) are provided. Regular eye exams help to reduce the chance of blindness and vision loss while staying on top of developing eye diseases such as cataracts and glaucoma.

2022 was CHC's first full year, 84 patients were provided free eye glasses





DERMATOLOGY

Provided by UPMC Mobile Dermatology to improve access to dermatology, to protect the largest organ in the human body, Dr. Alaina James, Pitt University Medical Students and UPMC partnered with the Community Health Center to provide dermatological services at the Center to the uninsured and under-insured. Dermatology services were provided to 24 CHC patients in 2022


